



Montana Atlas 15 Pilot Engagement Invitation

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) is excited to invite you to attend the NOAA Atlas 15 Montana Pilot Workshop on February 25th, 2025 from 10 AM - 5PM MT at the Missoula Public Library (455 East Main Street Missoula, MT 59802).

This workshop aims to engage end-users of precipitation data to help inform the development of NOAA's new precipitation frequency product, NOAA Atlas 15, to be released in 2026. The engagement will familiarize attendees with the Montana Atlas 15 Pilot, released in late September 2024, and solicit feedback on the interface and visuals and inform the final Atlas 15 product (note that the data in this pilot is for demonstration purposes and is not for application; Atlas 14 Vol. 12 is still the authoritative dataset in Montana).

The workshop will include a technical presentation on NOAA Atlas 15, a website demonstration, a user needs roundtable, and a feedback discussion. This is an opportunity to share your input to ensure NOAA understands how Atlas 15 can be improved to be useful, usable, and used.
